# Episode 1: The Whispering Tree

## 語彙解説

- whisper (ささやく)
- glow (ほのかに光る)
- gently (やさしく)

Elin lives in Lunewood, a quiet forest village. She walks in the woods every morning. One day, she hears a soft voice.

“Hello,” the voice says. Elin looks around. No one is there.

She sees an old tree with silver leaves. The tree glows gently.

“Did you speak?” Elin asks.

The tree does not answer, but a leaf falls into her hand. It is warm.

Elin smiles. “Maybe magic is real,” she whispers.

## Episode 2: A Letter in the Wind

### 語彙解説

- breeze (そよ風)
- notice (気づく)
- follow (～に従う)

Elin finds a letter near her door. It has no name.

She opens it. The paper smells like flowers.

“Follow the wind,” it says.

Elin walks outside. The wind moves her hair.

She follows the breeze into the forest.

There, she sees a small stone house she has never noticed before.

# Episode 3: The Forgotten Path

## 語彙解説

- moss (苔)
- symbol (記号・象徴)
- gate (門)

The stone house is empty. But behind it, Elin finds a narrow path.

The path is covered with moss and flowers.

She walks slowly. Birds sing above her.

At the end, she sees a wooden gate.

It has a symbol: a tree with stars.

Elin touches the gate. It opens by itself.

## Episode 4: Tea with Grandmother

### 語彙解説

- nod (うなずく)
- listen (耳を傾ける)
- quiet (静かな)

Elin tells her grandmother about the gate.

Her grandmother smiles. “That gate is old magic,” she says.

They drink tea together.

“Magic is quiet here,” Grandmother says. “It listens, not speaks.”

Elin thinks about the tree.

“Can I learn it?” she asks.

Grandmother nods. “Start with listening.”

# Episode 5: The Dream Pool

## 語彙解説

- pool (池)
- disappear (消える)
- calm (落ち着いた)

Elin walks to a small pool in the forest.

The water is clear and still.

She looks into it and sees herself—but different.

The other Elin smiles and waves.

Then she disappears.

Elin feels calm.

She writes in her notebook: “Magic shows what we need.”

## Episode 6: A Visitor from the City

### 語彙解説

- visitor (訪問者)
- strange (不思議な)
- full of (～でいっぱい)

A girl named Mira comes to Lunewood.

She wears bright clothes and talks fast.

Elin shows her the forest.

Mira laughs. “This place is strange.”

Elin smiles. “It’s quiet, but full of stories.”

Mira finds a glowing stone.

“Is this magic?” she asks.

Elin nods. “Maybe.”



# Episode 7: The Book of Small Magic

## 語彙解説

- kindness (優しさ)
- silence (静けさ)
- poem (詩)

Grandmother gives Elin a book.

It is old and smells like leaves.

Inside are short poems and drawings.

One page says: “Magic is in kindness, in silence, in care.”

Elin reads it again and again.

She writes her own poem:

“Magic is a warm leaf in my hand.”

## Episode 8: The Choice

### 語彙解説

- curious (好奇心がある)
- drop (落とす)
- understand (理解する)

Mira asks Elin to visit the city.

“It’s busy and exciting,” Mira says.

Elin thinks. She loves Lunewood, but she is curious.

She walks to the Whispering Tree.

“Should I go?” she asks.

The tree drops two leaves.

One is green, one is gold.

Elin smiles. “I understand.”

# Episode 9: The Night of the Stars

## 語彙解説

- wish (願い)
- star (星)
- answer (答える)

Elin and Mira sit under the stars.

The sky is full of light.

Elin tells stories about the forest.

Mira listens quietly.

A star falls.

Elin makes a wish.

“I want to learn more,” she says.

The wind answers with a soft song.

# Episode 10: Elin's Way

## 語彙解説

- journey (旅)
- edge (端)
- strong (強い)

Elin packs a small bag.

She hugs Grandmother.

“I’ll come back,” she says.

She walks with Mira to the edge of the forest.

The trees whisper goodbye.

Elin feels strong.

She does not know the road, but she knows herself.

Her journey begins.
